

Summarized essence of the account of the late Dr. John B. Tsu by Olin Yang; the interview was conducted with him in person on June 29, 2010

At the outset of his remarks and account of the late Dr. John B. Tsu, Olin stated that he may have been one of those who did come to know of the late Dr. John B. Tsu without me having any political affiliations. In his view, the late Dr. John B. Yang is a classical social and political person if not a politician.

I met him through a person by name of Dr. Yang in 1995. I came to this country in () and was trying to go into some kind of business in order to set out my business in the States. I incorporated a business corporation in 1995. I started a publishing business in 1998 and the late Dr. John B. Tsu was kind enough to let me use the photo of him in my magazine. He was, then, 78 years old.

I began to develop another business which may have been tied to what I studied in China where I went to China Academy of Medical Science.

I offered my service of driving him to whatever meetings he was to be there.

He was often loaded with very tight schedules because he had to attend to such meetings in order to be in touch with the peoples involved in grassroots movements for the cause of Asian Americans. He was the man of energy and aspiration. He was such a humble man that he could easily mingle with all levels of persons. He was a man with the sense of compassion, kindness and very less-selfishness. He has earned the respect of all levels of peoples.

He seemed to be a man who just kept going for what he was aimed for. He was missionary in a sense that he treated others equally regardless of their social status. I just cannot think of anyone who

was so energetic trying to do something good for others. It is sad that he passed away and it is almost over five years since the passing away of the late Dr. John B. Tsu.
